









The production audit will:

- Identify skills and level of expertise within the management team
- Focus on the entire value chain and identify areas of possible suboptimization
- Try to visualise activities that add value to the products such as internal transportation, intermediate storage, unnecessary handling and change-over of production
- Evaluate whether production time and capacities are fully utilised by machinery, operators and management
- Identify waste and excess consumption of raw materials and other materials
